To enhance students’ musical potential	To employ a pianist for accompanying choir rehearsals and performances in the coming year	Students’ standard in choral singing can be developed to a higher level with the assistance of a professional pianist. The selection of songs for performance can increase in quantity as well as varieties. Their self-confidence will also grow with the increased chances to perform inside or outside the school	Beginning October this year, a professional pianist will be employed to accompany choir rehearsals and performances.
