## 2022-2023 年度中一至中五級中期考試安排及注意事項(更新)

(更新日期: 2023 年 1 月 30 日)

各位家長:

按教育局及衛生防護中心就 2019 冠狀病毒病的最新指引(2023 年 1 月 20 日版本), 此家長信會取代 2023 年 1 月 6 日由學校發出有關中一至中五級上學期考試的家長信。

中一至中五中期考試將於 2023 年 2 月 1 日(星期三)至 2 月 17 日(星期五)舉行, 請留意考試時間表內容(見附頁)。各級考核範圍已上載 Google Classroom 供同學參考。

考試期間, 回校時拍咭點名後, 學生如需出席第一節考試, 必須於八時十五分前到達考試課室點名; 若學生不需要出席第一節考試, 則可按照考試時間前十分鐘到達考試場地點名。各科考試時間及地點可能有異, 請細閱考試時間表內容(見附頁)。

沒有考試的日期, 學生不需要回校上課。如考試期間由於天文台發出紅色/黑色暴雨警告或八號或以上颱風訊號而教育局宣佈停課, 當天考試將延至沒有編排考試的日期進行。有關詳情, 屆時請參閱學校網頁通告。

另外, 為確保同學在安全的校園環境下考試, 請家長留意以下事項。

- 每天回校前, 同學須量度體溫及完成快速抗原測試; 請家長確認體溫正常、檢測結果為陰性後, 並在學生手冊內之「量度體溫及快速抗原檢測紀錄表」簽署。(已提交有關證明, 簽署豁免定期進行快速抗原測試證明的同學除外。)
- 由於政府將不再發出隔離令, 如同學不幸確診 2019 冠狀病毒病或同學在當天早上的快速測試結果為陽性, 家長或監護人須於當天早上八時十五分前, 致電校務處通知校方及保留核酸檢測結果或快速抗原測試結果\*等證明資料。另外, 同學必需向註冊醫生求診並向學校呈交有效病假證明書及家長信。

(\*在快速測試棒上寫上姓名、班別、日期並拍照作記錄)

根據校規, 本校不設補考。學生必須準時出席所有考試。如因病告假, 須於二月二十一日(星期二)前向校務處呈交家長信及有效病假證明書, 違者缺考之卷別作零分計算。詳細考試規則已張貼於課室壁報板上, 家長亦可於學校網頁參考有關文件。

請家長督促子女勤加溫習, 以求鞏固學習內容及取得良好成績。

**2022-2023 S1 to S5 Mid-Year Examination Arrangements and Points-to-note (Revised)**

(Revised on 30 January 2023)

Dear parents,

With regard to the latest guidelines of the Education Bureau and the Centre for Health Protection on COVID-19, this parent circular will replace the parent circular issued by the school on 6 January 2023 for '2022-2023 S1 to S5 Mid-Year Examination Arrangements and Points-to-note'.

Please note that the mid-year examination for S1 to S5 will be held during the period from 1 February 2023 (Wednesday) to 17 February 2023 (Friday). Attached please find the examination timetable. The examination syllabuses have been uploaded to Google Classroom for students' reference.

During the examination period, when students arrive at school, they should tap the student card for the attendance record. If students need to attend the first session of the examination, they have to get seated in the examination venue before 8:15 am. Otherwise, they should get seated at least 10 minutes before the examination starts. Examination time and venue may vary for each subject, please refer to the examination timetable for details.

For the days that the students have no examination, they are not required to go to school. In case the Education Bureau announces class suspension due to red/black rainstorm warning signals or typhoon signal No. 8 or above has been hoisted by the Hong Kong Observatory during the examination period, the examination for that day will be postponed to a date when no examination is scheduled. For details, please refer to the announcement to be posted on the school website.

In addition, in order to ensure a safe environment during the examination, please note the followings:

- Every day before going to school, students must measure their body temperature and complete a rapid antigen test. If the body temperature is normal and the test result is negative, parents should sign on the "Body temperature and Rapid Antigen Test Record" in the student handbook. (Except for students who hold a certificate of exemption from regular rapid antigen testing and have submitted relevant certificates).
- As the Government will no longer issue isolation orders, if a student is unfortunately infected with COVID-19 or the rapid antigen test shows a positive result in the morning, the parent/guardian must inform the school office by calling the telephone number at 2323 1741 before 8:15 a.m. and keep the nucleic acid test result/rapid antigen test result\*, etc. as evidence which should be provided to the school upon request. The student concerned must seek medical attention from a registered medical practitioner in order to obtain a valid sick leave certificate.

(\*Please take a photo of the RAT stick with the student's name and class, and the date written on it.)

According to school regulations, **the school will not arrange supplementary examinations.** Students must attend all examinations. If students could not attend the examination due to illness, they must submit a parent letter and a valid sick leave certificate to the school office before 21 February 2023 (Tuesday). For those who fail to comply with the requirements, the score of the subject paper concerned will be zero. Examination rules have been posted on the notice board in each classroom. Parents may also refer to relevant documents on the school website.
