正向家長教育電影巡禮《你在嗎》親子電影欣賞暨分享會

各位家長:

為協助家長掌握支援子女健康成長及照顧子女身心健康的知識和技巧,教育局將於 2024 年 11 月至 12 月期間聯同家庭與學校合作事宜委員會及賽馬會「樂天心澄」靜觀校園文化行動(由香港賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助)合作舉辦正向家長教育電影巡禮—《你在嗎》親子電影欣賞暨分享會。

有關活動共設有四個場次,屆時除了欣賞電影外,亦有教育心理學家與家長分享提升家庭情緒健康的秘訣,以及聆聽子女心聲和促進親子關係的方法。此外,分享會設有互動環節,促進家長反思與子女的相處之道,幫助家長掌握正向育兒的知識、技巧和態度。是次活動費用全免,有關活動詳情如下:

電影簡介:	由香港賽馬會慈善信託基金捐助製作的《你在嗎》以鐘錶為核心意象, 以孩童視角觀察經營餐廳的父親與女兒及母親的相處日常。這部片長約 40分鐘的電影旨在引導家長反思與子女的相處方式,從而提升親子關係 及家庭成員的情緒健康。 《你在嗎》是一部香港電影,由麥婉欣導演執導,陸駿光、潘芳芳及李 昀蔚領銜演出。電影在美國獨立短片獎(洛杉磯)中勇奪多個獎項,包 括最佳外語短片(評審團特別獎)、最佳兒童短片、最佳原創劇本、最佳 女導演、最佳男演員(陸駿光)及最佳小演員(李昀蔚)。

Positive Parent Education Film Gala Presentations "I Have Arrived" Parent-child Film Appreciation and Sharing Sessions

Dear Parents,

To assist parents in acquiring the knowledge and skills of supporting the healthy growth of their children and taking care of their children's physical and psychological health, the Education Bureau (EDB) will organise the Positive Parent Education Film Gala Presentations - "I Have Arrived" Parent-child Film Appreciation and Sharing Sessions in collaboration with the Committee on Home-School Co-operation and Jockey Club "Peace and Awareness" Mindfulness Culture in Schools Initiative (funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust) from November to December 2024.

There are a total of 4 events of this activity. Apart from film appreciation, EDB has invited educational psychologists to share with parents on the tips of enhancing the emotional well-being of families, as well as ways to listen to their children's voices and promote parent-child relationship. In addition, an interactive session will be arranged during the sharing to foster parents to think about the way of getting along with their children and to assist them to acquire the knowledge, skills and attitude of positive parenting. The activity concerned is free of charge. The details of the activity is as follows:

Film Description:	"I have arrived", produced with the funding provided by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, uses clocks as the core image and captures the daily interactions between a father who runs a restaurant and his daughter and mother from a child's perspective. The 40-minute film aims to guide parents to reflect on their interactions with their children and to enhance parent-child relationship as well as the emotional well-being of family members. "I have arrived" is a Hong Kong film directed by Yan Yan Mak, starring Alan Luk, Lily Poon, and child actress Leona Li. The film garnered several awards at the Independent Short Awards (Los Angeles, USA), including Best Foreign-Language Short of the Season (Special Jury Award), Best Children Short, Best Original Story, and Best Female Director, Best Actor (Alan Luk), and Best Child/Young Actress (Leona Li).
