

Cool new school move

The Education Bureau has given Cognitio College (Kowloon) a piece of land in the Kai Tak development



site for a new campus. It will relocate from its 40-year-old grounds in San Po Kong.

“We aim to develop an environmentally proactive [and] creative school which provides strong links with the local community and enhances the development of the new district,” said vice-principal Bill Cheung Chan-piu.

Students will actively reach out to the local community to run green projects. The school, which is to open in 2017, also plans to welcome members of the local community to make use of school facilities, Cheung added.

Creative arts education will be a key focus of the new school, which will continue to be a “learning” school, aiming to facilitate whole person development of students, Cheung said.
