Principal's Message

The Cognitio Symphonic Band Concert and three rounds of preamble performances before the introduction talks plus school tours were successfully held on 9 November and 23 November 2024 respectively, with the presentations gaining rounds of applause.

Supported by the Quality Education Fund, our symphonic Band was founded in 2000 by former Principal of Cognitio College (Kowloon) and present Chairman of the School Administration Sub-committee of Incorporated Management Committee, Mr. Tsui Siu Keung. The band continued to grow despite constraints during the COVID pandemic, until now there are around 40 members playing brass and woodwind, instruments on the stage. Under the tutelage of the Band Director, Mr. Lee Kwok Ki Joseph, the Band has been participating in various events and competitions, with astounding and commending feedbacks from the audience, embracing parents, alumni and others.

The concert was presumably arranged as a five-yearly celebration of students' performance in music to celebrate the Band's 20th Anniversary. The originally scheduled occasion in 2020 was by no means held for social distancing reasons. This music event also served as the rehearsal to pave way for the Silver Jubilee festivity, which is planned to be organized in a larger scale in the next school year.
